FINAL ORDER

UPON investigating the claim the subject of or relating to Provisional Order dated the nineteenth day of July 1956 in respect of the piece of land known as Rempit

District of Madang
called "the claimed land")

(hereinafter

AND UPON reading the documents listed in Schedule "A" to this Order

AND UPON hearing the allegations made on behalf of the parties

THE LAND TITLES COMMISSION DOES HEREBY DECLARE,
in pursuance of the provisions of the New Guinea Land Titles Restoration Ordinance 1951-1963 that, in connection with the claim to re-establish ownership, as at the appointed date, of interest in or in respect of the claimed land it is established that on the appointed date no restorable interest was owned by (a) The Mission of the Holy Ghost (New Guinea) Property Trust
(B) The Director of Native Affairs on behalf of the Director of District Services and Native Affairs
(hereinafter called "the claimant")

SCHEDULE "A"
