PROVISIONAL ORDER.

IN CONNECTION with the claims to re-establish ownership, as at the appointed date, of interests in or in respect of the parcel of land described as

REMPI, District of Madang, containing about 4765 hectares, a sketch plan of which is attached hereto

THE COMMISSIONER OF TITLES HEREBY PROVISIONALLY DECLARES, in pursuance of the New Guinea Land Titles Restoration Ordinance 1951-1955, that it is established that, on the appointed date, the following interests in the parcel of land described above was/were owned by the following person(s)

Estate in fee simple as to part not coloured green by The Mission of the Holy Ghost (New Guinea) Property Trust.

This Order is made subject to survey and to the exact determination of native rights.

The area occupied by Rempi Church is provisionally declared not to be native land.

The claim on behalf of the Director of District Services and Native Affairs by the Director of Native Affairs to the areas coloured green as Native Reserves is provisionally disallowed.

The roads running through the piece of land are to be excluded from the title.
